This is Cooper Max. Cooper was diagnosed with an extra renal rhabdoid tumor on February 20, 2015. He had 14 rounds of chemo and 37 rounds of radiation. Cooper's last treatment was on December 23, 2015. Cooper loved to play guitar, pretend to be a cowboy, and drive his trucks.

On March 4, 2016, he went in for his 3 month follow up scans. The "disease was back in his left lung" were the words his doctor used.

On March 16, 2016, Cooper died after a struggle with fluid in his lungs from the tumors. Cooper was 4 years old.
